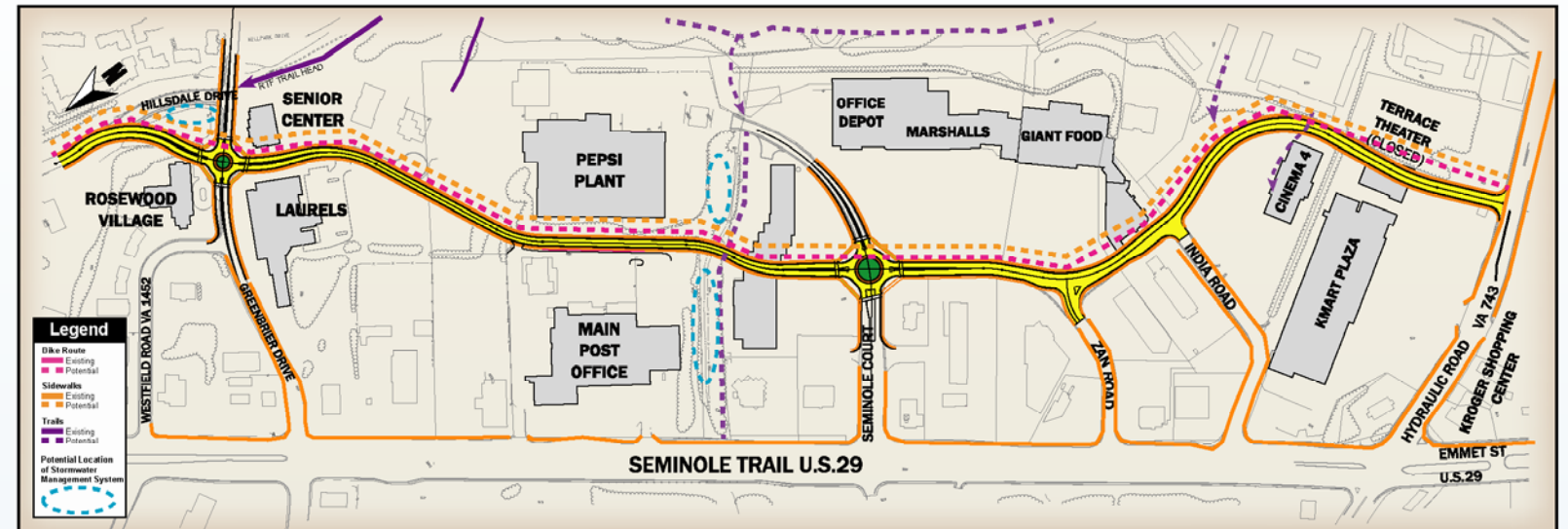

PURPOSE OF TONIGHT'S MEETING

- Present conceptual design criteria for the Hillsdale Drive Extension Project
- Present initial traffic data and analysis for the corridor and major intersections
- Begin discussion on landscaping opportunities and pedestrian and bike trails
- Receive public input on the project

PROJECT HISTORY

On March 7, 2005, the City of Charlottesville passed a resolution approving the location of the proposed Hillsdale Drive Extension utilizing the Alternative “C” alignment. On April 6, 2005, Albemarle County passed a similar resolution in support of the project. On July 21, 2005, the Commonwealth Transportation Board approved the same location for the extension of Hillsdale Drive.

The Hillsdale Drive Extension will begin on existing Hillsdale Drive north of its present intersection with Greenbrier Drive and continue south between the Pepsi Plant and the Post Office, through the Seminole Square Shopping Center, and will tie into Hydraulic Road between Virginia Dominion Power and the Kroger Store.

This important transportation corridor will provide a multi-modal alternative to the existing Route 29 corridor for local traffic and improve access to existing and future businesses in this area.
